

REGIONAL SUPER LEAGUE: Hockey

Players and Team Officials: Code of Conduct

As a player selected by your Club and competing in an event held or sanctioned by GVHA and CVHA, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during the event and in any role you hold within the regions.

1. Must behave in a sportsmanlike manner at all times to other players, officials and spectators.
2. Make no detrimental statements in public in respect of the performance of any match officials or umpires.
3. Play by the rules at all times and ensure that the game of hockey is not brought into disrepute.
4. Accept responsibility for all actions taken. Exercise reasonable care to prevent injury by ensuring that you play within the rules. Reasonable care consists of showing due diligence in abiding by the rules and adhering to the official's decisions.
5. Do not engage in any doping practice, the use of drugs or other banned substance unless prescribed by a medical doctor.
6. Do not bet on the outcome or on any other aspect of a hockey match or competition.
7. Do not throw or fix a match, try to achieve a contrived outcome to a match or competition, or otherwise influence improperly the outcome or any other aspect of a match or a competition.
8. Do not show unnecessary obvious dissension, displeasure or disapproval towards an umpire, technical official, tournament director or other official as a consequence of his or her decision or generally.
9. Abstain from the use of tobacco and the consumption of alcoholic beverages when playing or whilst in the players' uniform.
10. The use of recreational drugs and drugs of addiction are prohibited.
11. Refrain from any sexual harassment towards other players and officials. Treat all participants fairly and within the context of their sporting activities, regardless of gender, race, and place of origin, athletic potential, colour, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs, socio-economic status, and other conditions.
12. Must not do anything which adversely affects or reflects on or discredits the game of hockey, Hockey Australia, Hockey Victoria or CVHA/GVHA, or any squad, team, competition, tournament, sponsor, official supplier or licensee, including, but not limited to, any illegal act or any act of dishonesty or fraud.

The RSL Commission is responsible for ensuring that the Code of Conduct is met at all times. If, in their opinion, there is a serious breach of the Code of Conduct the player may be suspended from the competition. Any additional expense incurred by either the RSL Commission and/or the associations will be the responsibility of the club registering the team. The player shall be responsible for retribution to the club.

Players and Team Officials: Insurance Declaration

Where Hockey Victoria approves or makes available a player accident insurance scheme, Affiliates who have teams entered in RSL: Hockey CV/GV conducted matches and have chosen not to take out such cover shall be required to:

- (a) advise all members of the team(s) that they are not covered under an HV approved player accident insurance scheme, and
- (b) provide the RSL: Hockey Commission with a written undertaking prior to the start of the competition in which their team(s) compete, that all the players affected by the Affiliate's decision not to participate in the player insurance scheme have been duly advised.

CVHA has a compulsory wearing of mouthguard policy. CVHA based players who have any reason not to comply with this policy must complete the Declaration Form below (co-signed by parent or legal guardian if under 18 years).
